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Introduction

Hamartomas are benign tumor-like lesions composed of mature, well-differentiated tissues arranged in a disorganized fashion, which can arise in almost any oftan Spinal hamartomas are rare, and to our knowledge, prenatal diagnosis of a spinal hamartoma has not been previously describe[1].
